### DEFINITIONS

**A fatal accident:** implies the death of a person

**A serious accident (users)** implies:

- Hospitalization for more than 24 hours for any reason but medical observation; or
- A life threatening injury to a person
- Amputation of limbs (arm or leg)
- Loss of eyesight
- More than two persons with significant injuries

**A minor accident** relates to other cases
