DEFINITIONS

A fatal accident: implies the death of a person

A serious accident (workers) implies:

- A life threatening injury to a person
- Any fracture, other than the fingers, thumbs or toes
- Any amputation
- Dislocation of the shoulder, hip, knee or spine
- Loss of consciousness, coma
- Loss of sight (whether temporary or permanent)
- Fracture to skull
- Multiple fractures to leg, arm
- More than two persons affected
